General Information

Thank you so much for your interest in Irving Youth Theatre's production of Beauty and the Beast, Jr!

Based on the original Broadway production that ran for over thirteen years and was nominated for nine Tony Awards, and the Academy Award-winning motion picture, *Disney's Beauty and the Beast JR.* is a fantastic adaptation of the story of transformation and tolerance. *Disney's Beauty and the Beast JR.* features some of the most popular songs ever written by Alan Menken and the late Howard Ashman, along with new songs by Mr. Menken and Tim Rice.

The classic story tells of Belle, a young woman in a provincial town, and the Beast, who is really a young prince trapped under the spell of an enchantress. If the Beast can learn to love and be loved, the curse will end and he will be transformed to his former self. But time is running out. If the Beast does not learn his lesson soon, he and his household will be doomed for all eternity.

Auditions

Each performer must submit a **1-minute song selection** by video. The song selection should be the musical style of *Beauty & the Beast, Jr.* The song may be from *Beauty & the Beast, Jr.* but it is usually not best practice to perform a song or monologue from the show for which you are auditioning.

Additionally, each performer is asked to submit a short **1-minute monologue** by video. The monologue should be similar in style to the role for which the youth is auditioning.

Workshop/Audition

Directors will welcome tentative cast members to the Workshop/Audition on Saturday, May 11, 2024. This will be an audition where tentative cast members will sing and read lines together and the directors will determine who the lead cast members will be. We will be looking for energy and the chemistry between performers and determining who would be the best fit for each role. Directors will have already reviewed your audition videos (due May 4)

Be prepared to Sing, Act, and Dance during the Audition Workshop. Come dressed ready to move - dance shoes are not required, but wear shoes you are able to move in (no sandals, flipflops, Crocs, etc.)

In addition to the video submissions, each performer/parent must complete the Audition Google Form. PARENTS must complete the Permission Google Form in order for each youth to participate in the performances.

HOW TO PREPARE FOR YOUR AUDITION

Review the Audition Tips on the Irving Youth Theatre website prior to creating your audition videos!

<u>Video Auditions</u> - ALL interested youth must submit an audition video with their Audition Form (available on the Beauty and the Beast Audition website page) All performers MUST have completed **Permission forms prior to auditioning. Permission Forms may ONLY be submitted by a PARENT.** Only those wishing to perform will submit song and monologue videos. (Tech Crew will just select the Tech Crew box without video submissions.)

<u>Video Guidelines</u> Be sure to slate yourself (introduce yourself) at the beginning of each video. You will create and submit two separate videos for your audition, one for the song and one for the monologue. You will use the links located in the Audition Form for each video submission.

Be sure you have good lighting, no distractions in your video (no ceiling fans or pets), Film directly forward, not from up too high or too low. Show your personality with the song and monologue selections. Smile and have fun! **<Think Disney Magic!>**

<u>Audition Materials</u> Please prepare a memorized monologue (just one person speaking) that is 1 minute in length. You may choose the style of monologue (but it is always best to match the style of the character of the role you would prefer.) The monologue should not be from *Beauty & the Beast Jr*. Please prepare a song selection that is 1 minute in length. You may choose any song (it may be from *Beauty & the Beast, Jr., but best practice is to choose a song in the style of the role you are auditioning for*) and you should provide your own accompaniment track in your video. No *a cappella* performances please. It is also best to NOT sing along with other singers. You will submit this song audition video through the Audition Google Form.
